



Melbourne Indigenous Transition School (MITS) Boarding House Refurbishment - 139 Richmond Terrace

Kane Constructions and their fit-out and refurbishment division are Australia's partner with Melbourne Indigenous Transition School (MITS) under an open book "at cost" approach to refurbish a new boarding house in Richmond, Melbourne. Works were handed over in January 2020.

MITS exists to create pathways to greater opportunity for Indigenous students from remote and regional communities, so that they may lead lives full of choice and opportunity.

Each year MITS delivers a Year 7 program to 22 students after which students can transition to Melbourne partner schools across Independent, Government and Catholic sectors.

The project involved re-purposing an existing church building into a new three-level boarding house containing 18 new bedrooms.
