SITE PROFILE

THE CABRINI HOSPITAL REDEVELOPMENT

An impressive state-of-the-art redevelopment is currently underway at the Cabrini Hospital, located on Wattletree Road in Malvern.

The original acute-care facility which houses 508 beds, currently offers a range of services such as, day procedures, emergency and intensive care, maternity, paediatric (children's) care and pathology, and is known as one of Melbourne's most renowned private hospitals.

The private health provider Cabrini commenced redevelopment of its Malvern hospital back in 2016. Now, with the new development known as the 'Gandel Wing' currently underway, the improvements will transform the available services which are currently on offer to all patients in the hospital.

Kane Constructions was appointed under a Design and Construct contract to deliver the \$75 million project by late-2019. With the demolition stage now complete, the construction phase of the project is currently underway, according to William Gullifer, Project Manager at Kane Constructions. "We hope to have the structure built to ground level by early September 2018, as long as the weather remains kind".

More visible signs of the new hospital building will emerge over the coming weeks and months, with framework material being delivered and concreting well underway. A tower crane was also recently erected; standing 32m above ground and has a 52m boom. Its maximum lift capacity is 24 tonnes at a 10m radius. The Cabrini Hospital project will generate over 300 jobs for workers throughout the construction phase.
